## Codification system used for the Certificate number

**Parking Certificate code format: AA-xxxx-BB-yyyyyy-C**

AA-xxxx = Identification code of the Certification Entity

where:

AA = country of certification entity  
xxxx = serial number of registration

This code is automatically generated by the web platform after the registration of an entity. After completing the registration process, the code will be shown in bold letters on the top left of the screen where the details of the certification entity appear.

BB-yyyyyy-C = Identification code of the Parking that has been certified

where

BB=country where the parking is located  
yyyyyy=serial number created by the certification entity with each certification or re-certification  
C = type of the certification, i.e. F = first certification of the parking, or R = repeat certification of the parking, or T = transition certification

### **Example 1**

A Certification Entity based in Germany is registering the results of a successfully audited truck parking based in Italy.

The certification code to be allocated (and included in the Certificate) will be:

**DE-0001-IT-000001-F**

Where:

DE-0001 = is the Identification code of the Certification Entity (was the first entity based in Germany that was registered in the web platform)

IT-000001-F = Identification code of the Parking that has been certified (was the first parking that the specific Entity has certified, and the parking was certified for the first time)

### **Example 2**

The same Certification Entity is registering the results of a successfully audited truck parking based in Spain.

The certification code to be allocated (and included in the Certificate) will be:

**DE-0001-ES-000002-T**

Where:

DE-0001 = is the Identification code of the Certification Entity (was the first entity based in Germany that was registered in the web platform)

ES-000002-T = Identification code of the Parking that has been certified (is the second parking that the specific Entity has certified, and the parking was certified through a transition certification process, i.e. was previously certified by another standard)
